WHAT IS MIAair?

MIAair (Airport Instruction and Readiness) is a dress rehearsal program developed by Miami International Airport that allows travelers with special needs to practice the travel experience in a safe environment to build confidence. Participants will check in at an airline ticket counter, receive a Transportation Security Administration (TSA) screening and board an aircraft for a mock flight experience.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any traveler over the age of six years is eligible for a MIAair tour. Children must be accompanied by one parent or guardian. Adults with special needs are also welcome on MIAair tours.

All tour participants must undergo a security background check in order to participate in the tour.



Anyone interested in booking a MIAair tour can simply fill out the MIAair tour form located at miami-airport.com/miaair.asp. A Miami International Airport staff member will contact you to discuss upcoming tours.





HOW OFTEN ARE TOURS GIVEN?

MIAair tours take place three times a year on a weekday at 10 a.m. After registering, an MIA employee will contact you to confirm the next available tour date.
