

Disk of International Trade 2006

Miami International Airport's (MIA) ***Disk of International Trade (DIT)*** consists of country trade inspections for each of the countries, which did business through MIA for calendar year 2005. You can see the annual trade for a given country, expressed in four columns showing export weight, export value, import weight and import value. Each column lists all the commodity-groups, which that country traded with MIA in 2005, and the percent change from 2004.

Additionally, this year you can also see the regional trade for each of the regions, which did business through MIA in 2005.

The ***Disk of International Trade*** is an easy to use, self-installing, self-running program.

Steps to Install:

1. Create 2 sub-directories
 - a. DIT2006 on your local hard drive. (C:\DIT2006)
 - b. Sub-directory under DIT2006 called INSTALL on your local hard drive. (C:\DIT2006\INSTALL)
2. Click on the first link below, called **File1**.
 - a. Click on the OPEN button. This will copy DITSetup.exe file. Be sure to copy this file to the new sub-directory (C:\DIT2006\INSTALL), which you just created.
 - b. Execute DITSetup.exe this will unzip program files. Make sure to unzip (C:\DIT2006\INSTALL).
3. Find the Setup.exe file.
 - a. Click Setup.exe. This will run the installation for the program files. Unzip the files to the sub-directory (C:\DIT2006).
4. To have an icon on the desktop copy the DIT.exe and Paste to the Desktop.
