Andre Ragin serves as Aviation Small Business Strategic Advisor for the Miami-Dade Aviation Department (MDAD) Minority Affairs Division, responsible for direct oversight of the memorandum of understanding between Miami-Dade County's Internal Services Department Small Business Development Division (ISD-SBD) and MDAD. He manages strategic collaboration between MDAD and ISD-SBD at an executive level to quickly resolve small business enterprise issues that may critically impact our business partners such as airlines, tenants, concessionaires, and contractors. In his role, Ragin promotes minority, disadvantaged and local small business participation in contracting opportunities at Miami International Airport and the County's four General Aviation Airports.
