

Oscar Alberto Aguirre Division Director, Capital Finance



In 2015, Oscar Alberto Aguirre assumed the role of Capital Finance Division Director, which oversees the areas of cash management, debt service, grant accounting and capital finance for the Aviation Department. He has more than 29 years of experience with the Aviation Department, beginning in 1988 as an accountant in the revenue and general ledger sections. In 1995, Mr. Aguirre was put in charge of the general ledger and the trade accounts payable sections, and was responsible for the preparation of monthly financial statements and reports for all general aviation airports. In 2004, Mr. Aguirre was appointed Airport Accounting Chief, responsible for all general ledger activities and overseeing the accounts payable section of the Accounting Division. Mr. Aguirre was also responsible for

preparing the Accounting Division's operating budget. Since 2006, Mr. Aguirre has served as the Aviation Department's functional lead on implementations and upgrades of its financial process management system as well.

Mr. Aguirre earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from Florida International University. He also holds professional certificates in project management and project management principles for information systems from Florida International University. Additionally, Mr. Aguirre earned an Airport Operations diploma from Airports Council International, which includes certificates in airside, terminal, landside and airport business operations.
