



Departmental Standard Operating Procedure (DSOP): 04-01

WRITTEN DIRECTIVE REVOCATION

SUBJECT: MIAMI-DADE AVIATION DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES NOT QUALIFIED FOR UNESCORTED ACCESS TO CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION, TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION STERILE AREAS, SECURITY IDENTIFICATION DISPLAY AREAS, AIRSIDE OPERATIONS AREA, AND/OR ANY OTHER AREA OF THE AIRPORT IDENTIFIED AS SECURED

Background:

DSOP 04-01 was executed in 2004 to allow for the reassignment of full-time, permanent status Miami-Dade Aviation Department (MDAD) employees whose unescorted access to secure and sterile areas of the Airport was revoked. However, a qualification of employment and a continuing condition of such employment, is the ability to retain a valid airport identification badge by meeting the security screening protocols required under Federal law. If an employee is unable to obtain or retain Federal security clearance, reassignment within the Department is not possible and therefore procedures under this DSOP cannot be carried out. As such, this DSOP requires revocation.

Authorization:

DSOP 04-01 is hereby revoked, not to be superseded, amended, or replaced. Pursuant to Chapter 25 of the Miami-Dade County Code, the Aviation Director may authorize policy and can therefore, upon proper justification, amend or authorize its revocation.

Revoked Policy: DSOP 04-01 Miami-Dade Aviation Department Employees Not Qualified for Unescorted Access to Customs and Border Protection, Transportation Security Administration Sterile Areas, Security Identification Display Areas, Airside Operations Area, and/or Any Other Area of the Airport Identified as Secured, effective August 23, 2004.
