Cargo and freight statistics for Anchorage International Airport (ANC) are excluded from the following tables as ANC reports combined in-transit (same aircraft) and enplaned-deplaned figures to ACI. ACI, based in Montreal, Canada, collects and reports data on passengers, cargo (freight and mail) and aircraft movements for over 2,000 airports throughout the world.
