

NOTICE OF DBE GOAL FOR
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 49 CFR PART 26

**ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERALL TRIENNIAL DBE GOAL FOR MDAD
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/26 TO 2027/28**

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 26, the Miami-Dade Aviation Department (MDAD) is preparing to establish an overall triennial goal for participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) in Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) – assisted contracts for Fiscal Years 2026 - 2028. MDAD invites commentary from small, minority and women owned businesses, general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which may have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, and the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs.

MDAD is proposing an overall goal of **15.5%** for participation by DBEs in MDAD projects for Fiscal Years 2026 - 2028, based on information currently available. The rationale for this goal and supporting information will be available for public inspection for 30 days from the posting of this notice at the address below during normal business hours.
