Ken Pyatt is the Miami-Dade County Aviation Department's Deputy Director responsible for overseeing all aspects of airport operations, security, facilities management and business development at Miami International Airport (MIA) and Miami-Dade County's four general aviation airports. MIA is the third-busiest international airport in the U.S. with passenger traffic in excess of 44 million per year and annual revenue over \$700 million annually from a wide variety of retail, restaurant, parking and real estate endeavors.

At Miami International, Mr. Pyatt directs a workforce of over 800 employees responsible for MIA's terminals and its four-runway airfield. His common sense, customer-centric management style has earned him an industry-wide reputation for management excellence.
